  - v. MOU with City of Bridges to rehab 6 properties on lower Lanark St
  - vi. Initial discussions with The PIttsburgh Project regarding enlisting volunteers to help with prep for development

vii. Also working with Rising Tides to put together a MOU to get more purchases

  - i. Partnered with Tickets For Kids/One Northside Grant
    - 1. PHCC and FCC working with youth
    - 2. One Northside Grant- taking young people to all sorts of events. Sports, arts, music
- b. Training a board of young people
  - i. Youth Development group to help run the program.
  - ii. Pilot Try Out- went to a HS to train the kids about boards...
    - 1. The kids had lunch and learned what the duties of an executive board member
    - 2. Started bringing in other professionals to discuss other kinds of organizations
- c. Partnered with the Pittsburgh Pirates to present the history of the Negro League -50 students attended, expansion on hold because of COVID

- d. Learn and Earn program
  - i. Teaching entrepreneurship skills, landscaping, community involvement.
- e. Harnessing energy of young people- middle school to high school. Trying to turn them into productive, useful, future oriented activity.
  - i. Starting group program called "rap session" with Ms. Pauline to gather insight and inspiration from the young people themselves.
